#### Other news of ESBN interest

Paperless coming into force 20 Feb 2021

Framework Agreement on Facilitation of Cross-border Paperless Trade in Asia and the Pacific enters into force on 20 February 2021 Following the ratification of China on 22 November 2020, and earlier ratifications/accession of Azerbaijan, the Philippines, Islamic Republic of Iran, and Bangladesh, this inclusive and enabling treaty will enter into force on 20 February 2021. The Agreement, effectively builds upon the large number of bilateral and (sub)regional paperless trade initiatives, ensuring greater harmonization and interoperability between systems and promoting adoption of international standards. It has the potential to cut trade costs by 25% and make contactless trade a reality where supply chains are resilient even in the time of pandemics such as the COVID-19. The Agreement in Chinese, English and Russian languages is available on the website of the Treaty Section of the UN Office of Legal Affairs, along with an up-to-date list of countries who signed, ratified or acceded to the Agreement link. #### 18-19 February 2021: 2nd Forum on Trade Digitalization for Sustainable Regional Integration

The Forum will feature presentations of selected bilateral, regional and global initiatives aimed at enabling the electronic exchange and legal recognition of electronic data and documents to reduce trade costs and boost regulatory compliance. Panelists will share insights on how governments may deepen cooperation in this area, including through collaboration with the private sector and enhancing South-South cooperation. The Forum will also provide updates on how frontier technologies such as blockchain and artificial intelligence are being applied to make trade easier and more inclusive.
